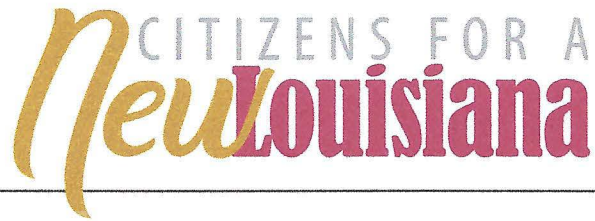

RE: FORMAL WRITTEN COMPLAINT AGAINST CHIEF OF POLICE TODD D'ALBOR

Honorable Mayor Freddie DeCourt:

This correspondence is submitted as formal complaint against Chief Todd D'Albor and other unknown persons who may have participated in the activities further described below. As Mayor for the City of New Iberia you are the "appointing authority" for the members of the New Iberia Police Department. It is incumbent upon the appointing authority to administer corrective and disciplinary action necessary for maintaining the standards of service. As such an investigation conducted in full compliance with the officer bills of rights is requested with regards to the following conduct:

Based on information and belief on or about February 2, 2026 Chief Todd D'Albor caused to be created and filed with the City of New Iberia and later with the New Iberia Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Board several personnel action forms concerning the employment of his step-daughter, Morgan Delcambre.

Those records were provided for inspection by my office on March 26, 2026. One record in particular showed a transfer of Delcambre from Transportation Officer to Police Records Clerk effective December 1, 2022 and provides the remark: "The employee meets all the requirements as established by the New Iberia Civil Service Board for the class of police records clerk. The employee is on the statewide list with a score of 82% which expires on April 4, 2023."

On March 26, 2026 my office submitted a public records request to the New Iberia Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Board seeking in part:

Request 4: Records reflecting the 82% exam score of Morgan Delcambre as indicated on the December 1, 2022 personnel action form.

Request 5: Records reflecting the 82% exam score of Morgan Delcambre as indicated on the February 2, 2026 personnel action form.

The City Clerk, Lanie Kerlegon, responded to our request on April 23, 2026 indicating: “Requests No. 4 & 5 – After further investigation, we are aware that there is no test score. The employee has been separated from the department.”

The records provided during the inspection and the e-mail from Lanie Kerlegon are all self-authenticating public records. Collectively they illustrate that the information provided on public documents contained false statements and representations of material facts.

Chief of Police Todd D’Albor and possibly other unknown members of the classified service have failed to perform their duties in a satisfactory manner, have committed an act(s) contrary to the public interest and policy, practiced fraud and/or deception with regards to test scores, willfully violated the provision of the Civil Service law and in so doing has shown he is unsuitable and unfit for continued service.

Please accept this formal written complaint against Chief Todd D’Albor and any other unknown persons who participated in the activities described above and launch an investigation within fourteen days as required by the Louisiana Police Officer Bill of Rights (LARS 40:2531) into the matter. Further, upon conclusion of the investigation please render prompt and appropriate discipline to all involved up to and including termination. There is no place for falsifying records within an respectable law enforcement agency.
