

**ORDINANCE NO. O-074-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING  
THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE NATIONAL FITNESS  
CAMPAIGN FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FITNESS COURT®**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the National Fitness Campaign has funds available for Fitness Court® construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary purpose of this grant is to build an important recreation facility to support the health of the community by making “world-class” fitness free in Lafayette, to fund an outdoor bodyweight circuit training Fitness Court®, and to earn local and national recognition as a leader in providing affordable health and wellness; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Fitness Campaign has \$30,000 in funds available for Fitness Court® construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary purpose of this grant is to assist with the provision of fitness equipment in order to promote the idea that exercise should be a routine part of daily life; and

**WHEREAS**, the total project cost is \$120,000 and there is a \$30,000 Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government commitment and additional \$60,000 in community fund raising required for this grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The Lafayette City-Parish Council hereby authorizes the filing of grant applications with the National Fitness Campaign and other fitness related grants as they may become available to fund construction of a Fitness Court®.

**SECTION 3:** The Lafayette City-Parish Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, cooperative endeavor agreement or contract, amendments, payment requests, completion reports, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
