COUNT 1: in that Jaiquan Jyriyenta Pierre, on or about July 3, 2025, did willfully, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess or have under the defendant's control with intent to distribute, a controlled dangerous substance, to-wit: Marijuana, classified in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act, in violation of R.S. 40:966. (Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana-Felony)

COUNT 2: in that Jaiquan Jyriyenta Pierre, on or about July 3, 2025, did willfully, unlawfully and intentionally refuse to bring a vehicle which he was driving to a stop, under circumstances wherein human life is endangered, knowing that he had been given both a visual and an audible signal to stop by one Quaid Lacombe, an officer of the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office, the said officer acting in his official capacity, and while he the said officer had reasonable grounds to believe that the driver had committed an offense, in violation of R.S. 14:108.1(C). (Aggravated Flight from an Officer-Felony)

COUNT 3: in that Jaiquan Jyriyenta Pierre, on or about July 3, 2025, did willfully, unlawfully and intentionally refuse to bring a vehicle which he was driving to a stop, under circumstances wherein human life is endangered, knowing that he had been given both a visual and an audible signal to stop by one Zachary Brown, an officer of the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office, the said officer acting in his official capacity, and while he the said officer had reasonable grounds to believe that the driver had committed an offense, in violation of R.S. 14:108.1(C). (Aggravated Flight from an Officer-Felony)

COUNT 4: in that Jaiquan Jyriyenta Pierre, on or about July 3, 2025, did willfully and unlawfully use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia, in violation of R.S. 40:1023. (Possession of Drug Paraphernalia-Misdemeanor)

CONTRARY TO THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA and against the Peace and Dignity of the same.
