107C SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES

1. WHITE MALE SUBJECT POSSIBLY TAKING PICTURES OF COMPLAINANT AT HEBERT'S. CALLER IS WAITING INSIDE OF THE BUSINESS.

Initial Report By : LEGRAND, TOBY On Date Of : 07/05/2021

On the above date and time, the St. Martin Parish Sheriff's Office Communication Division (Dispatch) received a call from a female complainant at the business of Hebert's Of Henderson about a white male suspect taking photograph of the complainant.

Dispatch made contact with me, Sgt. Toby J. Legrand and informed me of the incident information and location. I responded to the business and on arrival, 1157hrs, made contact with the complainant [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] was upset and crying stated that a white male suspect with a blue shirt and khaki shorts was taking inappropriate photos of her. Ms. [REDACTED] advised she took a photograph of the suspect before he left to have to show me. I looked at the photograph on her cell phone and saw it was a white male with a blue shirt khaki shorts with a hat as she stated to me. I asked Ms. [REDACTED] about what time this incident happened approximately. Ms. [REDACTED] advised that approximately 1130hrs-1155hrs

she wasn't sure. I asked Ms. [REDACTED] to email the photo to my department email and asked her to write a statement of the incident. Ms. [REDACTED] did write a statement and once completed, I collected the statement form and checked the form. I found in Ms. [REDACTED] statement she stated that she was walking in the business and found that the male suspect was following her around with his phone recording under her dress area. I also found that [REDACTED] described the suspect also on the form. I took [REDACTED] information and she stated to me that the business employees advised her there was camera surveillance. I asked the store clerk if the manager was at the business to view and upload the footage. The store clerk advised that the manager would be in at 1300hrs. I finished getting all the information and went check to see if the photo [REDACTED] sent was in my email. Once in my unit, I found that the photo was there and viewed it a second time. I identified the suspect as Bryce J. Meche of Henderson. I went back in the business and advised the complainant I did receive the photo and asked her if she had any further questions. Ms. [REDACTED] advised all she wanted was to be call on the out come of the incident. I advised her she would be contacted by someone. I left the business, 1205hrs, and responded to 1020 Serrette where Mr. Meche lived. I arrived at the address, approximately 1210hrs, and made contact with Mr. Meche's. I asked Mr. Meche what happened at the business of Hebert's. Mr. Meche advised that nothing happened that the complainant was tripping for nothing. I took Mr. Meche's information and asked him to write a statement. Mr. Meche agreed freely to write a statement, did write a statement and advised the same as what he told me verbally. I finished up at the residence at approximately 1237hrs.

I then responded back to the business, Hebert's of Henderson at approximately 1300hrs and made contact with the Manager James Allemond, gave him the approximate times needed (1135hrs to 1155hrs), Mr. Allemond was able to find, export and down load the footage of the incident. I thanked Mr. Allemond and responded to Henderson Police Department to view the footage. Once at the office, 1440hrs, me and Officer Randal Broussard did view the the footage and approximately around 1140hrs on the footage on Ch07-4138 and Ch23-4150 found that there was a crime committed and approximately around 1459hrs, Capt. James Thibodeaux was contacted by Ofc. Broussard about the incident. Capt. Thibodeaux advised us by speaker phone call, due to conflict of interest with the case to contact the sheriff's office, and asked if they could take the case over. Ofc. Broussard hung up the speaker phone call, contacted the Sheriff's Office, at approximately around 1503hrs and spoke with Lt. Captiville on speaker phone call, informed him of the situation with the incident and to assume the investigation. Once LT. Captiville got all the information and advised he would have Sgt. McBay come to the police department. Sgt. McBay responded to the office, approximately 1515hrs, and was briefed on the incident and given copies of the statements obtained along with the surveillance footage. Sgt. McBay advised she would be assuming the incident, had dispatch get her a case number for there department, gave me the case number for my report and left the office approximately 1540hrs. I had nothing further to report on this incident and the Sheriff is now in charge of the rest of the investigation with this incident. Sheriff's Office incident number SM21-22900.
