Thank you for your response.

To clarify, the Breaux Bridge water/sewer records for 910 Cecile Boulevard were subsequently obtained by the District Attorney and introduced in the Hubert Augustine candidacy proceeding. The copies contain printed date/time information indicating when the records were generated by the City.

Since the City advises that it has no records responsive to my request concerning who requested or received those records, please consider this a supplemental public records request for:

1. Any system audit log, access log, print log, user activity record, report-generation history, or other electronic record reflecting the retrieval, viewing, printing, exporting, or generation of the water/sewer account records for 910 Cecile Boulevard on the date and at or near the time reflected on the copies produced in the Augustine litigation (August 13, 2026 08:50);
2. Any record identifying the City employee or user account that accessed, generated,

- printed, exported, or otherwise produced those records;
3. Any communication between any City employee and the Office of the District Attorney for the 16th Judicial District concerning Hubert Augustine, 910 Cecile Boulevard, or the water/sewer account associated with that address; and
 4. Any subpoena, request from law enforcement, investigative request, court-related request, or other demand through which those utility records were requested or provided.

Dear Records Custodian:

Pursuant to Article 12, Section 3 of the Louisiana State Constitution of 1974 and the Louisiana Public Records Law, R.S. § 44:1 et seq., I request that you, as the custodian of records please produce the following public records for my review sufficient to identify the person or persons who requested from the City of Breau Bridge the water and/or sewer account records for 910 Cecile Boulevard, Breau Bridge, Louisiana, which were printed on AUGust 13, 2026.

More specifically, I request:

1. Any public-records request, written request, request form, visitor/request log entry, email, letter, or other document reflecting the request for those utility records;
2. Any record identifying the name of the individual or entity that made the request, together with the date and time the request was made;
3. Any correspondence or communications between the City and the requester concerning the request or production of those records;
4. Any record reflecting when the responsive utility records were retrieved, printed, copied, transmitted, picked up, or otherwise provided to the requester; and
5. Any transmittal email, cover letter, receipt, acknowledgment, or other record showing what documents were provided and to whom they were provided.
